

What is the Superintendent authorized to do in dealing with periods of inclement weather?

- 1. Close all the schools if conditions warrant such actions.*
- 2. Delay the opening of school by up to two hours.*
- 3. Operate well-defined alternate bus routes.*
- 4. Dismiss school early under certain carefully monitored conditions.*

How will parents be informed regarding school plans during periods of bad weather?

- 1. The Superintendent and his staff will evaluate weather and road conditions prior to 5:00 a.m.*
- 2. You will receive an alert via the Instant Messenger Alert System.*
- 3. A message will be posted on our web home page at www.newportwildcats.org*
- 4. Newport Schools participate in the SCHOOL CLOSING WIRE. That is, certain radio and television stations announce school closing information by districts as reported from our office.*
- 5. Parents are urged to listen for NEWPORT INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS or the identification number 2480. If you do not hear NEWPORT INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS or the identification number, our schools will be operating on a regular schedule.*
- 6. Parents are urged to listen to or watch the following stations for weather and school information when inclement weather conditions prevail:*
