What is High School Insights?

Insights is a powerful and potentially life-changing experience.

Insights brings to life the beauty of Catholic Social Teaching for students from Catholic high schools in our diocese. Through prayer, speakers and interaction with children in inner-city parochial and public elementary schools, students learn about the issues that effect these children.

The program takes place in downtown Covington, at either Mother of God church or First Christian church. After the morning presentation, the students visit an inner city elementary school, either an ACUE school or a Covington public school.

During the morning session students listen to presentations from professionals who are intimately involved in inner city education, and who are members of the Catholic community. The students then visit an ACUE or Covington public school, tour the school and then spend time with the children and get to know them.

After the school visit, the students spend time processing the day, journaling and sharing responses. Students then plan activities based on what they have learned.

What are the Goals of the Youth Insights Program?

Goal 1: Students spend time with children and connect with them on a personal level.

Goal 2: Students learn the difference between the myths and the realities relating to poverty.

Goal 3: Students organize and implement service project that address the needs of children in inner-city schools.

Who Can Participate?

High school students who attend Catholic high schools in the Diocese of Covington. This program has been designed to help to fulfill the Diocesan Synod objective that high school students learn about the seven principles of Catholic Social Teaching

When are Youth Insights?

High School Insights is scheduled usually during the second half of the school year. A typical High School Insights schedule is from 9a.m. to 2p.m. with additional driving time to and from school. We can be flexible in working with your schools needs and schedules
