Mathematics Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II Mathematics will be taken all 4 years of high school. (An integrated, applied or technical course that prepares a student for a career path based on ILP may be substituted if the course meets the content standards in the Program of Studies.)	3
Science Physical Science; Biology; Earth/Space Science Credits shall incorporate the content strands of biological science, physical science, earth and space science, and unifying concepts.	3
