

Senior Event Contract

As a senior at Newport High School it is imperative that you lead by example. We are requiring that all seniors have a definitive explanation of the requirements to participate in the graduation ceremony. The following are non-negotiable for the 2017-2018 Senior Class.

1. All seniors will be Transition Ready and give their best effort during all assessments. If you are unable to become Transition Ready you will be able to participate in a Senior Service Project. Participation in the Senior Service Project is mandatory.
2. Attendance Policy: Senior have three options for participation. The three options are prom, senior week, and participation in the graduation ceremony. After eight unexcused attendance events (this includes tardies and full days), seniors will lose one of the options. After nine unexcused attendance events, seniors will lose another option. After ten unexcused events, seniors will lose their last option. All options are subject to forfeit due to extreme behavior, emotion, or safety concerns. Once a senior reaches six unexcused attendance events the parent/guardian will be called and brought in for an attendance meeting to make the parent/guardian aware of the senior's attendance.
3. Poor behavior and attitude will not be tolerated during school hours, during after school activities, or any other school. Extreme and chronic issues will result in possible loss of participation in senior events.
4. No tennis shoes will be worn during the ceremony. All shoes must be brown or black.
5. You will not receive your diploma at the ceremony. You must return the next week for the diploma.
6. You will throw your caps after the ceremony. We will take a picture of all seniors after the ceremony throwing caps.
7. Pay all fees accrued while a student at Newport High School.
8. Successfully complete 24 high school credits as approved by the Newport Board of Education
9. Senior prank is not acceptable. If you participate in a senior prank you will lose your privilege to participate in the graduation ceremony.
